Learn 2 Sail Camp

Who should take this course? Novice/intermediate sailors, ages 8-18. Students will use OLSS sailboats – (one of our 8 “420” sailboats – same type used for high school and collegiate competitions)

What if my child has some sailing experience? Instructors are conscious of varied levels of experience and arrange students into three levels (420 Crew, 420 Skipper and 420 Trapeze and Spinnaker) to accommodate all levels of learning. Experienced instructors monitor student’s capabilities and move them to the appropriate level as they master greater skills. Sailing curriculum is monitored and adjusted to suit class dynamic, individual comfort, and skill building.

What will my child learn? To start, our US Sailing Certified instructors will introduce material in a classroom setting before heading out to spend the majority of the session on the water. While on the water, sailors will receive group and one-on-one coaching to improve skills and sense of confidence on the water. As the class grows and learns together the instructors may introduce more advanced activities.

What do we need to bring? Students must bring their own lunches and snacks as well as a lifejacket, change of clothes, water shoes and towel.

When? June 12th, 13th and 14th from 9:00am to 12:00pm
August 13th, 14th and 15th from 9:00am to 12:00pm

Where? Okauchee Lake Sailing School W340 N6338 Breezy Point Road

Cost? \$100.00 per student. Students who sign up for additional sessions this season will be credited with a credit equal to half of the fee for this session.
